

The Crystal Skull Kit

Cystal skulls gained notoriety in the mid-1800's, and they remained a curiosity until the mid-1900's. Now they are relegated to the status of "myth." They were claimed to have been made by the Aztecs and Mayans in pre-Columbian America, and were prized by European Museums and collectors.



The crystal skull above had been on display at the British Museum. This, and many others like it, have been shown to be frauds – having being made at about the time of their “discovery.”

You don't have to be Indiana Jones (did you see the movie?) to own one. Now you can make a “crystal skull” of your own! *Crystal Skull* is our newest stained glass sculpture kit. The sculpture is six inches high, five inches wide, and seven inches deep. It is created out of 265 pieces of glass. And, as the photo of our original sculpture shows, you can put a light bulb inside to create a fascinating display or a functional night light.

The Kit consists of a urethane Bodiform (that has every seam line carved into it), a six-page set of *Triple-Action* Template Sheets, six pages of Pattern Sheets, a fourteen-page *Stained Glass Secrets* booklet, and – our pride and joy – a twelve-page Instruction Manual with sixty-one full color step-by-step photos! The Triple-Action Template Sheets are: (1) numbered in the order in which you will use them; (2) positioned in the approximate location as on the Bodiform; and (3) printed in the approximate suggested colors.

We made our skull with opaque colors. If you use clear textured glass, you will have a Crystal Skull that is close to being the *notorious* crystal skull.
