

Gambel's Quail

This is the beautiful little Gambel's Quail. This little fellow is only eleven inches long, but he is made of 214 pieces of glass. He utilizes six different colors of glass. His *Comparative Time Rating* is 6.4.



What does the Kit contain? It has every important thing you need to complete this Masterpiece except the usual supplies: glass, solder, copper foil, flux, patina, or base. Here is the contents list:

Our exclusive template sheets that we print on self-adhesive paper for easy affixing to the glass of your choice. You do not have to trace around them with a pen or crayon and have the lines disappear while wet grinding.

We assume you have the usual stained glass tools, but you will also need a beveling bit (sometimes known as a lamp bit), some T-pins, some rubber bands, a pair of rubber dishwashing gloves (which you will cut down), and a three-foot length of 1/8” brass rod. You will need two brass washers and two concave brass washers. You will also need an electric drill. Triangular wedges would come in handy, and the *Secrets to Stained Glass Sculpture* tells you how to make them easily, but you can use small blocks of wood instead.

We have always called the Gambel’s Quail the little gem of our collection. If you can manage it – working with small pieces, that is – you will get no end of satisfaction from completing this little Masterpiece
